- Class 14 Painting – oil or water colour– not exceeding A3 if mounted.
- Class 15 Arts & Crafts Aged 12 and Under \*
- Class 16 Arts & Crafts Aged 13+ \*

## COMPETITION RULES

1. Children must be the age of their class or under on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2025.
2. Class 12/13 – The photograph must be mounted on card no bigger than A4.
3. Class 14 – **Must be an original piece of work by the entrant.**
4. Class 3/15/16 – Any item or picture that is homemade including knitting, Woodwork, crochet, pottery, drawing. – not exceeding A3 if mounted.
5. A Competition Entry form must accompany all entries; this can be found within this schedule or available on the day.
6. **All entries must be your own work; the judges' decisions are final**
7. Unnamed entries will not be accepted. Please fix your name firmly to your exhibit where it **cannot** be seen by the judges.
8. Family Team name must be clearly stated on entry form at the time of entry.
9. All competition entries must be collected between 4 and 5pm (not prior to 4pm) on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> May 2025 from the Ifield Barn Arts Centre. After this time entries may be disposed of at the discretion of the Ifield Mayfayre Committee.
10. Trophies must be returned in March 2026
11. Entry fees applicable. Children's entries are free, the family and adult classes are £1 per entry.
  - ❖ There will be rosettes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each class.

*Entries will be accepted on Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> May from 2pm - 4pm and on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> May from 9am – 10.30am. It would be appreciated if you could make every effort to bring your entries on SUNDAY - Ifield Barn Theatre is very busy on the morning of the Fayre and it helps us to display your exhibits to their best advantage, and NO vehicular access is available on MONDAY at any point.*

*Judging will commence sharply at 11am on the morning of the May Fayre, therefore we will not be able to accept entries after 10.30am.*

*Entrants are not permitted in the Exhibition Hall until 11:45am. Presentation of the prizes will take place outside the main entrance of the Ifield Barn Theatre in the afternoon.*
