ELECTORAL ROLL

Every six years, we need to prepare a new church electoral roll – 2025 is that year!

Are you baptised?

Are you aged 16 years+?

If so, we invite you to complete an Electoral Roll form.

What does this mean for me?

Representation on the governing bodies of our church depends on the number of people on the roll.

If you wish to stand for election to the PCC or other synodical council (Deanery, Diocesan or General Synod), being on the roll is compulsory

Joining the Roll gives you the right to attend and vote at the APCM (annual parochial church meeting).

It enables you to choose who stands on the decision-making body of the church.

How do I register on the Church Electoral Roll?

Please complete an application form.

Application Forms are available in Church or downloadable from website www.ifieldparish.org

The deadline for this year's return is **Monday 31st March 2025.**

Please return your form to Clare Wilson (PCC Secretary and Parish Electoral Roll Officer) in church, by email: pccsecretary@ifieldparish.org or via Revd. Christine Spencer.

When you provide an email address on the electoral roll form, you will be added to the iKnow Church database. You will then receive an invitation to confirm your preferences regarding how the church can contact you through this database. This process will enable us to communicate with you in your preferred manner, once you have established your permissions.

If you do not wish to be added to the iKnow Church database, you can decline permission, and your email will be removed. Please note that any communication will be strictly related to church matters, and your email will not be shared with anyone who does not have administrative rights within the iKnow Church database.

PALM CROSSES

If possible please bring last years' palm cross to church (and leave it in the basket on the table by the door) before Sunday 2nd March so that it can be made into ash for Ash Wednesday.

Please don't bring it after 2nd March – save it for next year! Many thanks
